2010.

On the basis of the data received electronically concerning the results of the election from

13 274 polling stations, which constitute 51,50% of the total number of polling stations, the

National Electoral Commission announces that the partial unofficial results of the election

with regard to the number of votes cast for individual candidates are as follows:

1) Number of eligible voters: 14 750 311;

2) Number of ballot cards issued: 7 991 937;

3) Turnout: 54,18%;

4) Total number of valid votes cast countrywide: 7 898 019;
