ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE NATIONAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE HELD ON

4 JULY 2010 AT 20:50 CET AT THE NEC'S HEADQUARTERS

On 4 July 2010 at 20:50 CET at the headquarters of the National Electoral Commission, the next conference was held concerning the overview of the second round of the Polish Presidential Election.

NEC's Chairman, Judge Stefan Jaworski opened the conference summarizing the vote held on 4 July 2010. The polling stations were open from 6:00 to 20:00 CET and the vote proceeded without any major disturbances. The National Electoral Commission did not report any organizational problems, i.e. there were no missing ballot cards, and the distribution of additional cards proceeded as previously planned. On the election day and the preceding night, there were a few minor violations of the electoral silence, which NEC informed about at the previous conferences. None of the Regional Electoral Commissions adopted a resolution on extending the duration of the vote.

NEC's Chairman, Judge Stefan Jaworski provided information concerning the process of

verification of votes cast in the second round of the Presidential Election. Once the vote ended, all the Local Electoral Commissions commenced the counting of the votes and submitting them electronically to Regional Electoral Commissions and the National Electoral Commission.

Finally, NEC's Chairman, Judge Stefan Jaworski informed that the first partial results received from 20% of the polling stations, mainly from hospitals, care homes and penitentiary institutions, as well as districts with lower populations will be known approximately at 23:00 CET.
