

**ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE NATIONAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION AFTER THE
PRESS CONFERENCE HELD ON
4 JULY 2010 AT 23:00 CET AT THE NEC'S HEADQUARTERS**

On 4 July 2010 at 23:00 CET at the headquarters of the National Electoral Commission, a press conference was held concerning the partial unofficial results of the second round of the Polish Presidential Election.

NEC's Chairman, Judge Stefan Jaworski opened the conference and announced the partial unofficial results of the Polish Presidential Election determined at 22:48 CET on 4 July 2010.

On the basis of the data received electronically concerning the results of the election from 5 398 polling stations, which constitute 20,94% of the total number of polling stations, the National Electoral Commission announces that the partial unofficial results of the election with regard to the number of votes cast for individual candidates are as follows:

- 1) Number of eligible voters: 5 922 405;**
- 2) Number of ballot cards issued: 3 232 832;**
- 3) Turnout: 54,59%;**
- 4) Total number of valid votes cast countrywide: 3 194 387;**
- 5) Number of valid votes cast for individual candidates was as follows:**
