ANNOUNCEMENT AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE OF THE NATIONAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION HELD ON

21 JUNE 2010 AT 5:00 CET AT THE NEC'S HEADQUARTERS

On 21 June 2010 at 5:00 CET the next press conference was held at the seat of the National Electoral Commission concerning the Polish Presidential Elections 2010.

The following participated in the conference:

The conference was opened by NEC's Chairman Judge Stefan Jaworski. Next, Judge Maria Grzelka announced the partial unofficial results of the Presidential Election determined as at 4:47 CET on 21 June 2010.

On the basis of the data received electronically concerning the results of the election from 24 304 polling stations, i.e. 94,30% of the total number of polling stations, the National Electoral Commission announces that the partial unofficial results of the election with regard to the number of votes cast for individual candidates are as follows:

1) Number of eligible voters: 28 735 147;

2) Number of ballot cards issued: 15 762 500;

3) Turnout: 54,85%;

4) Total number of valid votes cast countrywide: 15 647 488;

5) Number of valid votes cast for individual candidates was:

Minister Czaplicki presented the information concerning the progress of the counting and verification of the results performed by Regional Electoral Commissions. The Minister mentioned that in 33 out of 55 Regional Electoral Commissions the counting of the votes had finished and the data had been submitted to the National Electoral Commission. 13 commissions – after the data have been verified - have been permitted to hand over the documentation to the National Electoral Commission. At the time of the conference, the National Electoral Commission received the aggregate protocol and verified the completeness of documents submitted by the Regional Electoral Commission from Skierniewice.

Minister Czaplicki announced that the final official results would probably be presented in the evening hours of 21 June 2010.
