NEC's Chairman, Judge Stefan Jaworski opened the conference and announced the partial unofficial results of the Polish Presidential Election determined at 01:54 CET on 5 July 2010.

On the basis of the data received electronically concerning the results of the election from 24 488 polling stations, which constitute 95,01% of the total number of polling stations, the National Electoral Commission announces that the partial unofficial results of the election with regard to the number of votes cast for individual candidates are as follows:

- 1) Number of eligible voters: 29 017 416;
- 2) Number of ballot cards issued: 16 044 051;
- 3) Turnout: 55,29%;
- 4) Total number of valid votes cast countrywide: 15 854 503;
- 5) Number of valid votes cast for individual candidates was as follows:
