On the basis of the data received electronically concerning the results of the election from

5 398 polling stations, which constitute 20,94% of the total number of polling stations, the

National Electoral Commission announces that the partial unofficial results of the election

with regard to the number of votes cast for individual candidates are as follows:

1) Number of eligible voters: 5 922 405;

2) Number of ballot cards issued: 3 232 832;

3) Turnout: 54,59%;

4) Total number of valid votes cast countrywide: 3 194 387;

5) Number of valid votes cast for individual candidates was as follows:
